

OKLAHOMA STATE BUREAU OF NARCOTICS AND DANGEROUS DRUGS CONTROL

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This is to inform you of changes to the Oklahoma Prescription Monitoring Program that will take place September 1, 2018.

The Oklahoma Prescription Monitoring Program reporting requirements will be moving to ASAP 4.2a software format. This change will take effect September 1, 2018.

Pharmacies, Veterinarians, and Dispensing Physicians, please familiarize yourselves with the new reporting requirements and make sure your software vendor knows about these changes.

Some of the changes will include the addition of the following ASAP fields:

DSP12 - Transmission Form of RX Origin Code.

DSP22 – Quantity Prescribed

DSP25 – Diagnosis Code

PRE09 – XDEA Number
